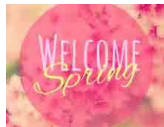

If you haven't had the opportunity to read about this great new lending program yet, Portage County District Library has begun lending Mobile Hotspots to its library cardholders- *at no cost*.

Basics of the lending program include: Must be a Portage County District Library cardholder 18 or older in good standing, Hotspots can be borrowed for two weeks, holds can be placed on them, and anyone borrowing a Mobile Hotspot must sign a user agreement.
